FEE SCHEDULE

- \$225 per hour per party for two parties
- \$200 per hour per party for three parties
- \$175 per hour per party for four or more parties

Any time spent on preparation or post-mediation will be billed at the same hourly rate.

THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM CHARGES APPLY

- Minimum of 3 hours for half-day mediation
- Minimum of 6 hours for full-day mediation

Fees will be divided equally among the parties unless otherwise agreed.

CANCELLATION POLICY

To avoid the minimum fee, cancellations or rescheduling must be made in writing before 5:00 PM EST, 8 days prior to the mediation date. Cancellations or rescheduling after this time will result in the minimum fee being charged, and all parties will be billed equally.

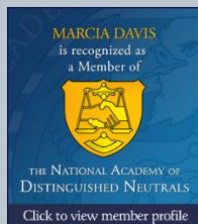

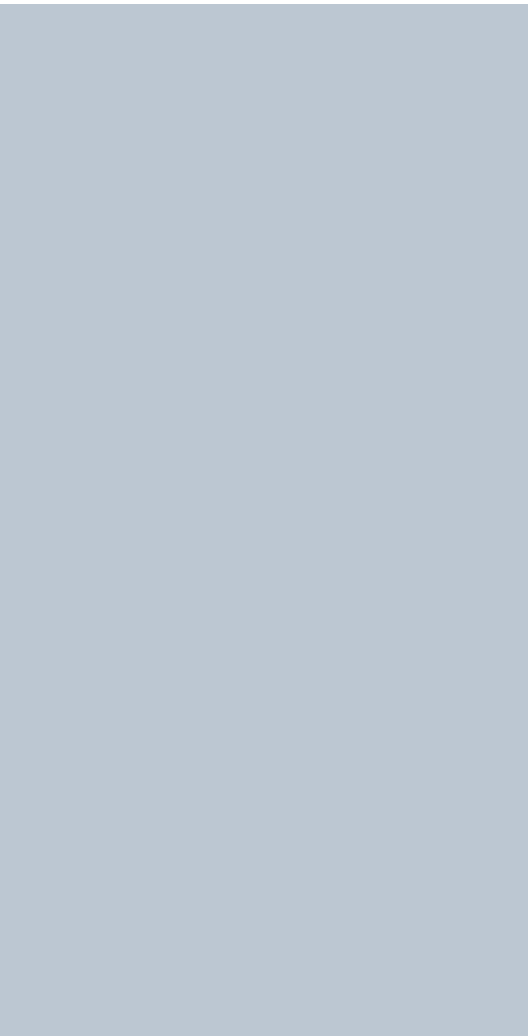
