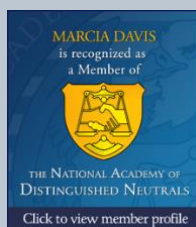

## FEE SCHEDULE

- \$225 per hour per party for two parties
- \$175 per hour per party for three parties
- \$125 per hour per party for four or more parties

Any time spent on preparation or post-mediation will be billed at the same hourly rate.

## THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM FEES APPLY

- Minimum of three (3) hours for half-day mediation
- Minimum of SIX (6) hours for full-day mediation

Fees will be divided equally among the parties unless otherwise agreed.

## CANCELLATION POLICY

To avoid the minimum fee, cancellations or rescheduling requests must be made in writing no later than 5:00 PM EST, eight days prior to the mediation date. Cancellations or rescheduling requests received after this time will result in the minimum fee being charged, and all parties will be billed equally.

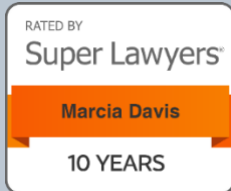
