FEE SCHEDULE

- \$225 per hour per party for two parties

THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM FEES APPLY

- Minimum of three (3) hours for half-day mediation
- Minimum of SIX (6) hours for full-day mediation

CANCELLATION POLICY
